50/50 Tree Program 2021

As a recognized Tree City USA, the Village of Olympia Fields, in conjunction with the Beautification Committee offers the 50/50 Tree Program to its residents to help "keep Olympia Fields green."

The Village **splits the cost of the tree** with the resident, thus providing a savings of 50% on the purchase price of the tree selected. Residents may purchase up to 2 trees. The order deadline is by noon on Monday, September 27, 2021.

Tree Size

Chinquapin Oak, Kentucky Coffee, Bitternut Hickory, and Bur Oak will be in a 20 gallon container. White Swamp Oak and Sienna Glen Maple will be approximately 2/2.5 inches in diameter and 4-6' tall.

Locating & Planting Trees

Tree(s) will be delivered to your home by K-Lee/DJ Landscaping, free of charge, with planting instructions. Residents are responsible for planting the tree(s) OR selecting service provider to do so. You must contact "JULIE" (1-800.892.0123) prior to planting so the companies can come out and make sure you are digging in a safe location no matter who is planting the tree.

Ordering Guidelines

- Completed order form with payment needs to be returned to Village no later than Monday, September 27, 2021 by noon.
- Confirmation of your purchase will be remitted via standard mail or email.
- Village will notify homeowners when tree(s) will be delivered (mid-October).
- Tree orders will be on a first come, first serve basis. Village funding is limited.

Chinkapin Oak - Full Price \$210

Resident Cost: \$105



A worthy specimen for larger lawns. A medium to large size oak with 4"-6 1/2" glistening dark green leaves in summer turning yellow-orange to orangish-brown in fall. Produces 1" sweet acorns that mature in a single season. The acorns are at the top of the food preference list for many wildlife species.

Mature Height: 40-50 feet

Mature Width: 40-50 feet

Light Exposure: Full sun (6 hrs direct light daily); Partial sun/shade (4-6 hrs light daily)

Preference: Well-drained soil; many different soil types

'Kentucky' Coffee - Full Price: \$210

Resident Cost: \$105



The tree's picturesque profile stands out in all seasons and can be attributed to a unique growth habit of coarse, ascending branches that often form a narrow crown. An excellent choice for large areas. It is also widely used as an ornamental or street tree.

Mature Height: 60-70 feet

Mature Width: 40-50 feet

Light Exposure: Full sun (6 hrs direct light daily)

Preference: acidic, alkaline, loamy, moist, rich, sandy, well-drained, wet and clay soils. While it tolerates wet soil, it has extreme drought tolerance.

'Bitternut' Hickory - Full Price \$210

Resident Cost: \$105



A large, native north American tree, best reserved for larger landscapes. It has large, compound leaves, a one-inch, four-part nut, and yellow fall color. Like all hickories, debris from its fruit drops from late summer throughout autumn, making fall cleanup in urban areas more challenging.

Mature Height: 50-70 feet

Mature Width: 40-50 feet

Light Exposure: Full sun (6 hrs direct light daily; Partial sun/shade (4-6 hrs light daily), Full shade (4 hrs or less of light daily)

Preference: Acid, moist, well-drained soil

'Bur' Oak – Full Price \$210

Resident Cost: \$105



The stately bur oak, native to the Midwest, is a great choice as a shade tree and for specimen plantings in spacious yards. Its massive trunk has gray to brown furrowed bark and its branches bear lustrous dark green leaves that turn yellow-brown in fall. Large acorns with fringed caps attract birds and small mammals.

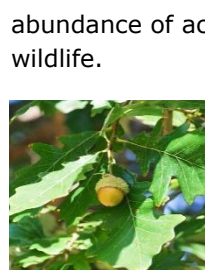

Mature Width: 70-80 feet

Light Exposure: Full sun (6 hrs direct light daily); Partial

White Swamp Oak Full Price: \$450

Resident Cost: \$225



A stunning tree with peeling bark and 2-toned leaves with dark green tops and silvery white undersides. Excellent as a shade tree in both rural and urban landscapes, it performs well in low-lying, wet areas and provides outstanding yellow Fall color. Also produces an

abundance of acorns that are eaten by many species of wildlife.

Mature Height: 50-60 feet

Mature Width: 50-60 feet

Light Exposure: Performs best in full sun (6 hrs direct light daily)

Preference: Thrives in wet conditions

Sienna Glen Maple – Full Price \$315

Resident Cost: \$157.50



A relatively new variety, the tree was patented in 2000. The tree is a cross between a silver maple and red maple. Sienna Glen Maple trees grow in a pyramidal form. This tree has a uniform branching habit. The leaves of this maple are pointed. The foliage is medium green in the summer and turns to a bright orange-red in the fall.

Mature Height: 50-60 feet

Mature Width: 35-40 feet

Light Exposure: Full sun (6 hrs direct light daily); Partial sun/shade (4-6 hrs light daily)

Preference: Tolerates wet & alkaline soil
