

Providing Vital Nutrition Services


Congregate dining sites are not open for sit-down meals but are providing to-go meals through 3/27. After 3/30, congregate sites will deliver shelf-stable meals as needed.

Dining sites should be contacting clients directly; call AgeOptions to help troubleshoot.

Partnering with Law Enforcement to Protect the Vulnerable

After a telephone assessment, Adult Protective Services (APS) claims will be referred to local law enforcement. To report suspected abuse of an older adult or adult with a disability, call the APS hotline 24/7 at (866)800-1409. During business hours, call AgeOptions if you encounter an issue making a report.
