Governor Pritzker Announced that Cook County Has Moved to Phase Four. What Does Phase Four Look Like?

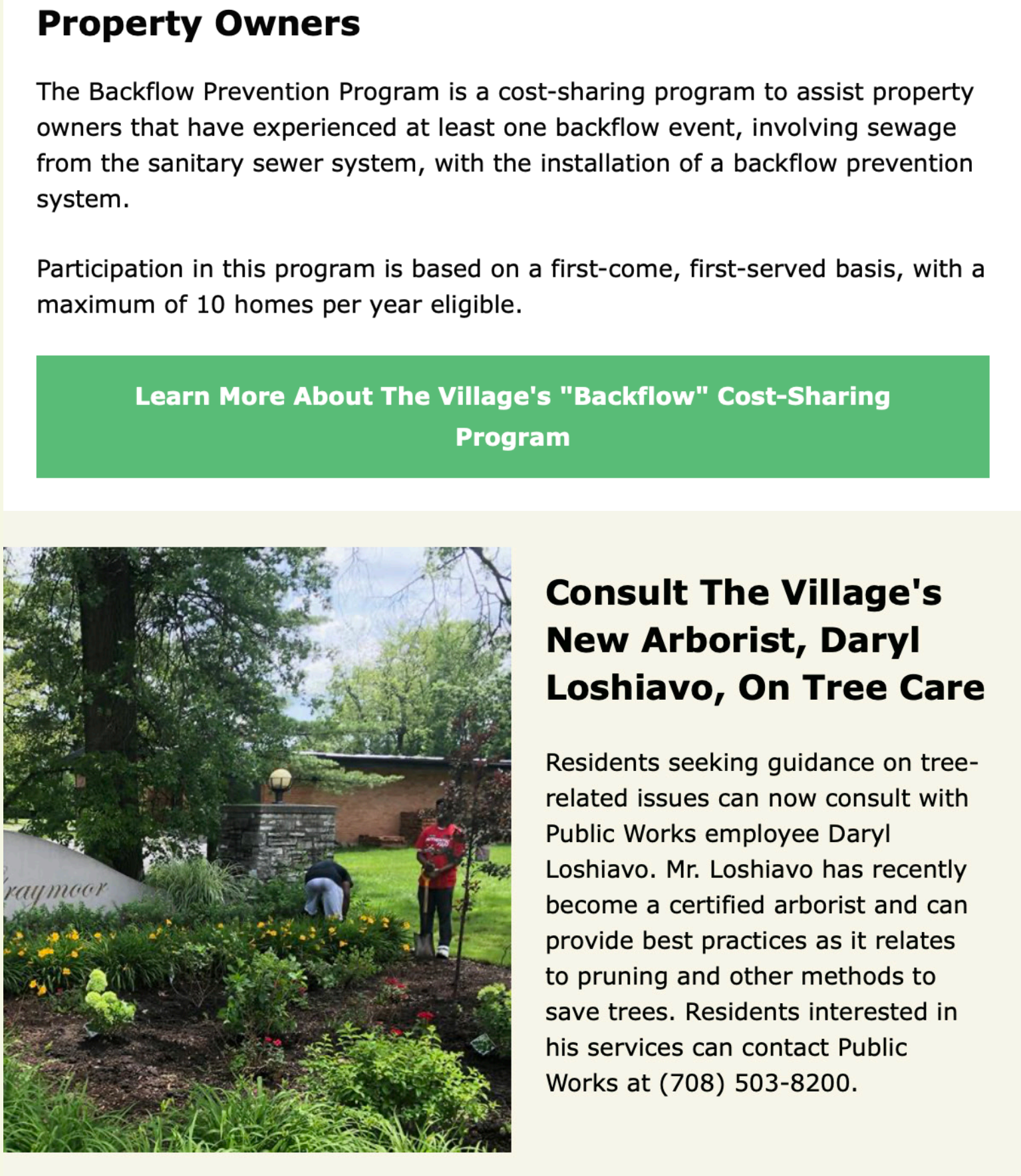
- **Bars and restaurants**: Open for indoor dining at 25% capacity
- **Personal care services and health clubs**: All barbershops, salons, spas and health and fitness clubs can be open at limited capacity
- **Entertainment**: Cinema and theaters open with capacity limits
- **Retail**: Open with capacity limits
- **Gatherings**: All gatherings of 50 people or fewer are allowed with this limit subject to change based on the latest data & guidance
- **Travel**: Travel should follow IDPH and CDC approved guidance
- **Health care**: All health care providers are open
- **Education and child care**: P-12 schools, higher education, all summer programs, and child care open with IDPH approved safety guidance
- **Outdoor recreation**: All outdoor recreation allowed
- **Manufacturing**: All manufacturing open with IDPH approved safety guidance
- **"Non-essential" businesses**: All employees return to work with IDPH approved safety guidance; Employers are encouraged to provide accommodations for COVID-19-vulnerable employees

Beautify Your Subdivision Entrance! The Village Board Has Allocated \$1,000 Per Homeowner Association (HOA)

The Village Of Olympia Fields Launches A Backflow Prevention Cost-Sharing Program for Property Owners

The Backflow Prevention Program is a cost-sharing program to assist property owners that have experienced at least one backflow event, involving sewage from the sanitary sewer system, with the installation of a backflow prevention system.

Participation in this program is based on a first-come, first-served basis, with a maximum of 10 homes per year eligible.

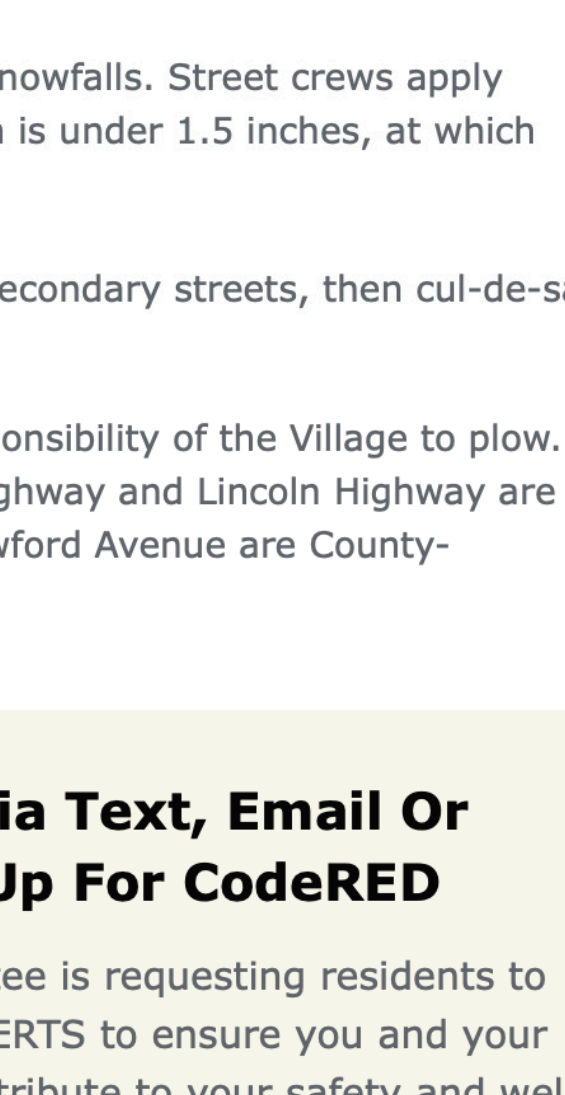

Protect Yourself Against Carjackings

Crimes of this type are on the rise in the entire metropolitan area. The Village has responded by sending alerts to residents indicating the nature of the crime as well as an awareness to reduce such incidents to keep you safe.



Exercise Heightened Awareness In Carjacking Hotspots, Including:

- Anywhere a driver slows down or stops
- Residential driveways (getting in and out of the vehicle)
- Parking lots and garages
- Gas stations
- ATMs
- Highway entry and exit ramps
- Intersections with stoplights

Follow These Safety Tips:

- Be aware of your surroundings.
- Make it a habit to start your car and drive away immediately.
- Look around for suspicious persons sitting in vehicles or loitering in the area before entering/exiting your vehicle.
- Park in well-lit areas that are visible to the public.
- Keep windows rolled up and doors locked no matter how short your trip or how "safe" the neighborhood.
- Trust your instincts. If you feel something is wrong, leave the area.
- When stopping in traffic at a stop sign or stop signal make sure you have room in front of you to maneuver and escape, if necessary.
- Keep your cell phone in your pocket. If your vehicle is stolen, you will be able to call 9-1-1.
- Teach your children to enter and exit the vehicle quickly.
- Create a Smart911 profile and include your vehicle information.

If You Are The Victim of a Carjacking:

- If you are confronted by a carjacker give up your car and leave the scene.
- Your vehicle can be replaced. You are irreplaceable.
- Avoid verbal/physical confrontations.
- Make a mental note of the suspect(s) description and their vehicle's description (if they have one).
- If there is a child in the vehicle, let the carjacker know "my child is in the car."
- Call 9-1-1 immediately to report the crime.

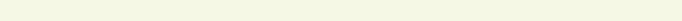
Limited supplies of COVID-19 vaccines are now available at select stores to individuals 16 years of age and older who meet state-specific eligibility criteria.

All You Need To Know About Village Snow Removal

The Village strives to have all Village-owned streets and public parking areas plowed and salted within 10 hours after a snowstorm has stopped.



Completion times are extended with larger snowfalls. Street crews apply highway deicer salt when snow accumulation is under 1.5 inches, at which point, plowing begins.

Busier streets are plowed first, followed by secondary streets, then cul-de-sacs and dead-ends.

Not all streets within the Village are the responsibility of the Village to plow. For instance, Western Avenue, Governors Highway and Lincoln Highway are state-controlled; and Vollmer Road and Crawford Avenue are County-controlled.

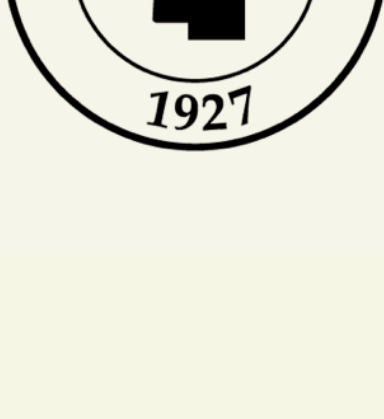
